

I've just heard that you have arrived at your new assignment and wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for the extraordinary work you did in Nepal on behalf of the U.S. program to resettle Bhutanese refugees. I acknowledge that you probably didn't literally exercise super-human powers to create the infrastructure and logistical framework for our resettlement program but it certainly seemed as if you did.

Your work to create not just the infrastructure for the refugee processing center in Damak -- a place with almost no pre-existing infrastructure -- but a medical screening and treatment facility with a tuberculosis lab that the CDC compares favorably to the best U.S. labs -- was incredibly impressive. You were under extreme time pressure at every step of the process. You came in on time (usually ahead of time) and within budget for every aspect of this project. Without your initiative, creativity, and sheer hard work, the U.S. Government would not have been able to keep its promises to the Government of Nepal and to the refugees themselves.

I congratulate you and wish you every success in the future. I hope that your future includes many more opportunities to serve the humanitarian interests of the people of the United States.
